
ORDERING A PLAQUE

Each tag will be a minimum donation of £12 or two for £20.

Pet remembrance PLAQUES

£50 | brass

This is the **exact size** of the plague which will be engraved on solid brass and added to our remembrance board in the peaceful surroundings of our memorial garden.

You can purchase a plaque, engraved with words of your choice to remember a special pet. The plaque (which measures 12.5cm x 7.5cm) will be placed on our remembrance board as a permanent memorial.

The garden, which we dedicate to the memory of the Society's founder, Peggy Henderson, is open for you to come and quietly reflect during sanctuary opening times, throughout the year. All funds raised from our memorial garden will go towards taking care of our cats, dogs and rabbits, ensuring that they receive all the necessary attention and loving care they need until we can find them new, forever homes.

To give you some idea of how much a £50 donation (and an accumulation of £50 donations) can help us see below:

- £52 pays for a rabbit to be spayed
- £100 pays for 34 microchips for our animals
- £250 pays for one member of Animal Care staff for one week
- £500 pays for three months supply of cat litter and kitten food
- £2,500 pays for an average monthly vet bill for cats, rabbits and dogs
- £5,000 pays for our vehicle running costs for the year
- £7,000 pays for our energy costs for the year
